

WHEN YOU CAN'T KEEP YOUR WEIMARANER

We realize that lives change, people move, babies are born, etc. and sometimes a Weimaraner needs to find a new home. Our first thought is for the welfare of the dog. We will do our best to work with you in finding a new home for your dog as soon as possible.

Our rescue volunteers may be able to assist you in placing your dog:



1) Contact us at 775 972-7804 or norcalweimrescue@yahoo.com. We will need to fill out a Rescue Dog Profile. This helps us write an informative description of your dog for our web site. Please have the following information available: Who did you purchase the dog from? Pedigree or AKC papers Medical Records Name of dog food Picture of the dog (digital) Description of personality, behavior, habits, training, etc. It is important that you be truthful and that all problems are disclosed. We need to know the correct age, behavioral problems, health or aggression problems, training and discipline problems. Has the dog bitten anyone? Old dogs and dogs with health problems can be difficult to place.

2) We will list your dog's description and picture on our web site.

3) We will screen inquiries and will contact you about possible homes. This process may happen quickly or may take several months to find the proper home.

4) We have limited foster homes. Because of this we would prefer that you keep your dog until placed if at all possible. If this is not possible, we will have you sign your's ownership over to Northern California Weimaraner Rescue. The dog will be placed in a temporary foster home.

5) If you wish to put an ad in the newspaper for placement of your dog, we will assist in writing the ad and screening inquiries.

6) Before placement, please spay or neuter your dog if not already done. We also request that shots be current and that the dog be tested for Heartworm.
